ICA2025 Organizing Entity: University of Novi Sad, Serbia

The headquarters of the 58th ICA will be the University of Novi Sad (UNS), located on the bank of the **Danube River** in the central area of the city. The University campus is an architecturally compact area that allows for easy and quick internal transportation, less than one kilometer from the historical center of the city where most of the hotels, restaurants and cultural events in Novi Sad are located. The Nikola Tesla international airport in **Belgrade** is less than an hour away by highway that connects the two most important cities in the country. The airports of **Timisoara** (Rumania), **Budapest** (Hungary) and **Vienna** (Austria) are also not too far away.

STRUCTURE

The organizational structure of ICA2025 Junior will consist of:

◊ Sessions with individual presentations

INDIVIDUAL PRESENTATIONS

- a) Individual presentations for the 58th ICA are accepted until December 31, 2024, through the platform <u>https://ica2025.uns.ac.rs</u>.
- b) Each proposal for individual presentations must contain the following information about each of the authors: name and surname(s) of the author, email address, institution to which he/she belongs, CV no longer than half a page, title of the presentation and abstract with a maximum of 250 words with 5 keywords. The call for individual presentations opens on October 31 and closes on December 31, 2024.
- c) The Organizing Committee will group the individual presentations into parallel sessions, according to their theme. The organizers of ICA Junior will also act as coordinators of the sessions.
- d) One proposal per person is allowed.
- e) Once their abstracts have been accepted, the participants will have a period of **1 month** to pay the registration fee.

PARTICIPATION MODES: IN-PERSON AND VIRTUAL

The ICA2025 Junior symposia will have two participation modalities: in-person, between June 30 and July 3, and virtual (parallel sessions through the Microsoft Teams platform), on July 4, 2025. There will be no hybrid events, except for the opening of the Congress and the keynote lectures.

OFFICIAL LANGUAGES

The official languages of the Congress are: Spanish, English, French, German, Portuguese, Italian and Serbian.
