HISTORY, CULTURE AND LOCAL VINES FROM FRUŠKA GORA

MONASTERY GRGETEG – SREMSKI KARLOVCI – WINERY

Dates of departure: June 29; June 30; July 1; July 2; July 3; July 4, 2025. / 1 day – by bus

## TOUR ITINERARY:

Departure from Novi Sad by bus. Trip to **SERBIAN ORTHODOX MONASTERY GRGETEG**, one of sixteen monasteries at the „Serbian Mounth Athos“. Visit to the monastery church dedicated to Saint Nicholas and introduction to Serbian history and the rich cultural heritage of the monastery. After the visit, we will drive to the town of **SREMSKI KARLOVCI**, the spiritual and cultural center of the Serbian people, a town of great importance for Serbian history and culture. During a walking tour, we will see cultural monuments and institutions mostly established during the 18th and 19th centuries: **The Orthodox Seminary** – the second oldest in the Orthodox world, **The Seminary Boarding School** – a dormitory for seminary students, **The Patriarchal Court** – a monumental 19th-century building, **Karlovci Grammar School** – the oldest Serbian grammar school, **The Cathedral Church** – a baroque church dedicated to Saint Nicholas, **The Roman Catholic Church** – dedicated to the Holy Trinity, **The “Four Lions” Fountain** – built in honor of the completion of the first Karlovci water supply system, **The Lower Church** – dedicated to the Holy Apostles Peter and Paul, in whose yard stands an old plane tree under state protection. We will then take a short walk to the Chapel of Peace, erected at the site where the **TREATY OF KARLOWITZ** was signed in 1699 (a European peace treaty) between the Christian forces and the Ottoman Empire. The Treaty of Karlowitz is also known as “The Austrian treaty that saved Europe.” This is the location where the round table was first used in international diplomacy. We will visit the chapel. Wine tasting at the **KIŠ WINERY**. Return to Novi Sad.

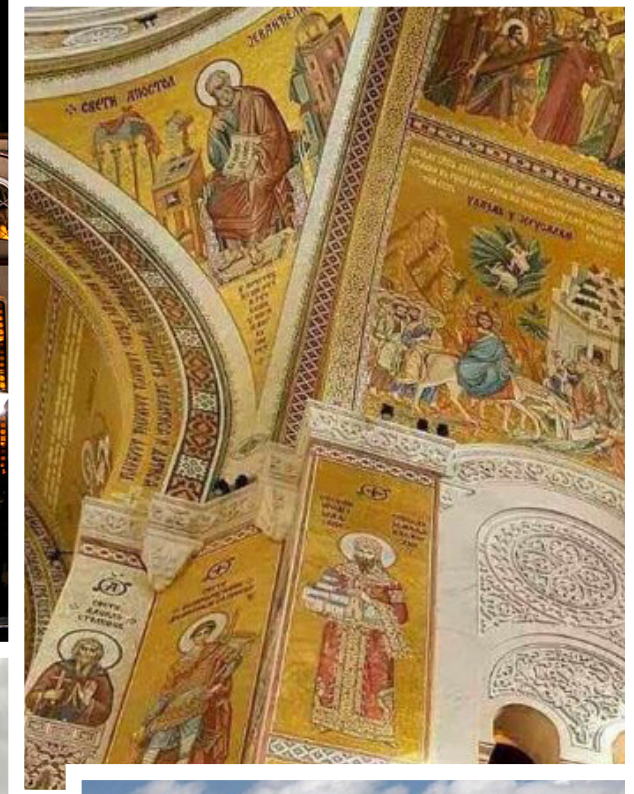
ST. SAVA TEMPLE – MUSEUM OF YUGOSLAVIA – MUSEUM OF YUGOSLAVIA

Dates of departure: June 29; June 30; July 1; July 2; July 3; July 4, 2025. / 1 day – by bus

## TOUR ITINERARY:

Departure by bus from Novi Sad at 08:30 AM. Travel via motorway to Belgrade. Arrival in Belgrade. Visit to the **MUSEUM OF YUGOSLAVIA**, one of the most visited museums in Serbia, and the **HOUSE OF FLOWERS**, a mausoleum of lifelong Yugoslav president Josip Broz Tito. After that, visit to the **TEMPLE OF SAINT SAVA**, the largest Orthodox temple in the Balkans, dedicated to the most renowned Serbian saint, Saint Sava. The program continues with a trip to Knez Mihailova Street, the central street of Belgrade, where you will have free time for a walk or lunch (up to two hours). Panoramic ride to New Belgrade and the confluence of two major European rivers, the Sava and the Danube. **Departure for a RIVER CRUISE**. During this unique experience of seeing Belgrade from its rivers, you'll see: Great War Island – Little War Island – Belgrade Fortress (Kalemegdan) – Nebojša Tower – Novak Djokovic Tennis Courts (SERBIA OPEN) – Milan Gale Muškatirović Sports Center – Confluence of the Sava into the Danube – View of Pančevo Bridge – View of Zemun – Museum of Contemporary Art – Beton Hala – Belgrade Port – Serbian Orthodox Patriarchate – Cathedral Church – Branko's Bridge – Old Fairgrounds – Belgrade Waterfront – Return to Yachting Club "Quay". Departure by bus back to Novi Sad. Arrival in Novi Sad around 7 PM.

# SECRETS OF PETROVARADIN FORTRESS

## PETROVARADIN FORTRESS WITH AN UNDERGROUND TOUR - CITY CENTER OF NOVI SAD

Tour dates: June 29, June 30, July 1, July 2, July 3, July 4, 2025 / 1-day walking tour

**WELCOME TO NOVI SAD**, the administrative, cultural, and economic center of Vojvodina – a welcoming and well-organized city with a cheerful, relaxed atmosphere that stands in contrast to the hectic pace of modern life. Three hundred years ago, as the mighty Fortress of Petrovaradin – the second largest in Europe – rose on the banks of the powerful Danube River to protect the empire, a small settlement known as “Serbian Town” emerged on the opposite shore, which would later grow into Novi Sad, an important hub of trade and craftsmanship. Novi Sad also became a city of culture, known as the “Serbian Athens”, and home to the most important Serbian cultural institutions. From its very beginnings, it has been a multicultural city where people of all faiths and nationalities have lived in harmony, each minding their own business and respecting one another.

### TOUR ITINERARY:

We begin our program with a visit to **PETROVARADIN FORTRESS**, known as the “Gibraltar on the Danube” – one of the largest, most complex, and best-preserved fortresses in Europe from the 18th century. While learning about its construction, the history of previous fortifications, and many fascinating legends, we will see the Clock Tower (known as the “Drunken Clock”), the city’s most iconic symbol, as well as the Officer’s Pavilion, artists’ studios, the Gunboat, and Leopold’s Gate. We continue with a journey into “underground Novi Sad” on a tour of the **UNDERGROUND MILITARY GALLERIES**, where we will walk through secret corridors lined with loopholes and trenches as we explore the fortress’s mine-based defense system. The tour continues with a visit to the **CITY CENTER OF NOVI SAD**, including stories about the Danube and the city’s bridges. We will explore the heart of Novi Sad: Danube Park, Dunavska Street, Zmaj Jovina Street, Liberty Square, and Theatre Square.

# A SREM STORY

NOVO HOPOVO MONASTERY - SIRMIUM (SREMSKA MITROVICA) - ZASAVICA - SPECIAL NATURE RESERVE

Dates of departure: June 29; June 30; July 1; July 2; July 3; July 4, 2025. - 1 day – by bus

## TOUR ITINERARY:

Departure by bus from Novi Sad. Journey through the **FRUŠKA GORA NATIONAL PARK** to the **SERBIAN ORTHODOX MONASTERY NOVO HOPOVO**, one of the sixteen monasteries of the “Serbian Holy Mountain,” dating back to the 16th century and of great historical importance for the Serbian people. Tour of the monastery church. After visiting the monastery, drive to the town of **SREMSKA MITROVICA**, formerly known as **SIRMIUM**, which, starting in 293 AD, became one of the imperial residences following the reforms of the Roman Emperor Diocletian. Sirmium was also the birthplace of nine Roman emperors. The tour includes a visit to the **REMAINS OF THE IMPERIAL PALACE** and the **LAPIDARIUM OF THE MUSEUM OF SREM**. The final stop of the excursion is a visit to the **ZASAVICA SPECIAL NATURE RESERVE** on the Sava River, protected by the state as a Category I natural asset. Tour of the reserve and a boat ride through its most scenic areas, featuring a vivid mosaic of forests, wetlands, wide riverbanks, a rich variety of plant and animal species, and a traditional river lifestyle. Free time for lunch and a walk to the farm that preserves **old indigenous animal breeds** (Mangalica pigs, Podolian cattle, Bosnian mountain horses, etc.) and produces **the world’s most expensive cheese – donkey cheese**. Return to Novi Sad.

## Đerdap Gorge Cruise – 1 Day (with Visit to Golubac Fortress)



**Short Description:** A one-day bus trip to the Đerdap region, where you'll cruise through the most stunning gorge on the Danube, visit the fantastically renovated Golubac Fortress, and explore Lepenski Vir, the cradle of European civilization. Enjoy Vlach specialties with a breathtaking view of the Đerdap Gorge and spend an unforgettable day full of wonderful impression

**Activities:** Visit the medieval Golubac Fortress

Enjoy the view from the most beautiful lookout point on the Danube

Don't miss the fantastic Vlach specialties at an ethnic household

Experience an unforgettable cruise through the Đerdap Gorge

Visit the unique archaeological site of Lepenski Vir

### Description:

Departure from Belgrade from a previously arranged location in the early morning hours (around 8 AM). After a little over 2.5 hours of driving, we arrive at the Golubac Fortress. Built at the very entrance to the Đerdap Gorge, surrounded by towers connected by ramparts and located in a very inaccessible spot, it held a significant position in the Ottoman conquest plans and fell into the hands of Bayezid I shortly after the Battle of Kosovo. Today, it stands as a cultural monument that recalls a distant past and now, newly renovated, welcomes tourists in all its glory. After visiting the fortress, we continue our journey by bus to Donji Milanovac. We transfer to Kapetan Miša's Hill for lunch featuring excellent Serbian and Vlach

specialties. At this location, one of the most beautiful viewpoints in Serbia, we enjoy a stunning view of the Danube and the unique atmosphere of the area. Next, we take a one-hour bus ride to Tekija. Here, we board a boat and begin our cruise through Đerdap, the deepest gorge in Europe and the largest national park in Serbia. We'll pass through the "Mali Kazan" (where the water reaches an incredible depth of 90 meters!), see old signaling stations, the head of King Decebalus on the Romanian side, and the famous Tabula Traiana on our side—only visible from the water! After the cruise, we travel by bus to Lepenski Vir. We will visit the 9,500-year-old archaeological site! Numerous scientific studies have confirmed that this site is, in fact, the cradle of European civilization. It was the center of one of the most important Neolithic cultures. Between 6,500 and 8,800 BC, the site was home to a settlement of at least a hundred residential and sacred structures. This settlement predates Ancient Greece, the pyramids of Giza in Egypt (2,560 BC), and any other known ancient cities (Jerusalem, Beirut, Damascus, and Aleppo in Syria, Byblos in Lebanon). Return to Belgrade in the evening.

# Belgrade

Today, you have the chance to see the main sights of this vivid capital and to feel the true spirit of Belgrade.

After 1,5 h drive from Novi Sad we start panoramic driving towards the St. Sava Temple. This landmark of Belgrade is one of the biggest orthodox churches in the Balkans located on an open plateau where a bronzed monument and church dedicated to Saint Sava can be found. Saint Sava is the founder of the Serbian Orthodox Church in 1219 and an important figure in medieval Serbia.

We will step into Tesla's wonderful world of science. In this unique location of Museum, you will meet original Tesla items and demonstrations of his pioneering inventions. After an interesting movie about Tesla's life, Museum guides present his inventions in an interactive way and after the presentation you will have the opportunity to see his personal belongings.



After visit of Museum, we continue panoramic drive along the streets of Belgrade prior to arrival to the main street and the central square – Republic Square and Knez Mihailo Street. On this square two of the most important cultural artistic institutions can be found, the National Theatre and the National Museum. A walk through the always lively Knez Mihailo Street, home to many national and international culture institutions (Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts, Centre Culturel Français, Instituto Cervantes and Goethe institute...), numerous cafes and restaurants, a few hotels and hostels, and lots of local and worldwide brand shops. The architecture of this street is a mixture of many of the styles featured in Belgrade and its surroundings are protected as important cultural heritage.

This colorful street is leading a visitor to Kalemegdan Fortress, the most important cultural and historic complex of the city. This fortress consists of the old citadel (Upper and Lower Town) and Kalemegdan Park on the confluence of the River Sava and Danube, in an urban area of modern Belgrade, the capital of Serbia. It has been declared a Monument of Culture of Exceptional Importance in 1979.

If the timetable permits you will enjoy also in some relaxing time according to the recommendation of your local guide prior to returning to the Novi Sad.
